Eligibility:	State and Local Government agencies are eligible to use this contract. A local government agency is any city, county, district, other local governmental body, or educational system including the California State University (CSU), the University of California (UC), K-12 public schools, and community colleges empowered to expend public funds.

Quotes and Purchase Orders:

Quotes are valid for 30 days from the creation date of the quote **OR** until the contract expires, whichever occurs first.

To obtain a quote, contact your local John Deere Dealer. Your local John Deere Dealer will contact the Direct Government Sales office for a direct sales quote.

All purchase orders must show Deere & Company as the vendor and reference the contract number.

Manuals	An operator's manual is included with the delivery of the equipment at no charge.



Miscellaneous

The State of California requires the following information to be listed on the purchase order before processing:

- Contract Number
- Itemized pricing for all codes
- Agency contact name
- Agency contact telephone number

Attachments for Field Conversion that are on contract must be purchased with a self-propelled base machine and are not eligible for purchase as separate items on this contract. Customers that would like to purchase Attachments for Field Conversion must contact their local John Deere Dealer or purchase from John Deere as Not Specifically Priced (NSP).

Multiple Unit Discount

Sales of 3 or more like <u>self-propelled products</u> sold on the <u>same</u> purchase order are eligible for the multi-unit discount. The 3 or more self-propelled products must be in the same equipment categories as shown below and included on the same purchase order. Compatible implements and attachments sold with such products also qualify for the multi-unit discount, but do not count as a unit. Frontier Equipment is excluded from the Multiple Unit Discount.

- Golf Equipment (includes Progators)

Open Market by John Deere (listed in the price book)

Allowed: Open Market items (Not Specifically Priced (NSP) items) are **implements**, **attachments**, **accessories**, **parts and bundles** that are not currently on contract, but are requested by the customer to complete the purchase of John Deere equipment awarded on contract.

Items must be clearly labeled on the purchase order as NSP.

Order Limitations:

- Purchase orders \$250,000 or less NSP items must not exceed \$5000
- Purchase orders over \$250,000 NSP items must not exceed 5% of the purchase order or \$25,000 whichever is lower.
