Eligibility:	This contract can be extended to all state agencies and to members of the State's Cooperative Purchase Venture (CPV) program at the same price, terms and conditions. John Deere dealers must appear on the State's approved list in order to quote, deliver and service equipment sold off this contract. 	Quotes and Purchase Orders:		

Quotes are valid for 30 days from the creation date of the quote **OR** until the contract expires, whichever occurs first.

To obtain a quote, contact your local John Deere Dealer. Submit your purchase order to your dealer. The John Deere Dealer will submit the purchase order to John Deere's Government Sales office.

All purchase orders must show Deere & Company as the vendor and reference the contract number.

Contract Details

Delivery	A parts CD and technical manual CD must be provided to the customer at no cost. Agency will be charged for additional manuals.
Obligations	Manuals must be included on the quote or the agency's PO. Dealer will be reimbursed.
Fees	A \$4 per loaded mile delivery charge is allowed and is optional. The charge should be clearly indicated on the agency's purchase order. Mileage distance will be the distance from the delivery starting point to the customer's delivery point ONLY. Mileages should be calculated using <u>Google Maps</u> . The ordering agency may use the dealer for delivery, may pick-up the equipment or may contract for delivery with anyone it chooses.



Financing	Not Allowed. No financing or leasing allowed.		
Machine Hours	Allowed: Due to factory delivery, pre-delivery inspection, machine setup and installation of attachments, machines may have hours but should not exceed hour usage guidelines in the warranty administration manual.		
Manuals	A parts CD and technical manual CD must be provided to the customer at no cost. Agency will be charged for additional manuals. Manuals must be included on the quote or the agency's PO. Dealer will be reimbursed.		
Miscellaneous	None.		
Multiple Unit Discount	Multiple unit discounts are permitted. The contract discount plus the multiple unit discount equals the total discount. Discounts are based on the following schedule:

	Sales of 3 or more like self-propelled products sold on the same purchase order are eligible for the multi- unit discount. Self-propelled products must be listed in the same tabbed price book section and included on the same purchase order. Compatible implements sold with such products also qualify for multi-unit discount, but do not count as a unit. Frontier Equipment is excluded from the multiple unit discount.		
Open Market by John Deere (listed in the price book)	Allowed with restrictions. Open-Market items are implements, attachments, accessories, parts and bundles that are not currently on contract, but are requested by the customer to complete the purchase of John Deere equipment awarded on contract. State and local agencies may purchase incidental miscellaneous parts, accessories and labor that are directly related to a specific item included on the contract. <u>These types of items may not exceed \$5,000 for an individual purchase order</u> . Total incidentals allowed on a single purchase order (Open Market by John Deere plus Open Market by Dealer) is \$5,000. <u>Items must be clearly labeled on the purchase order or quote as Open Market</u> .		



Open Market by Dealer (not listed in the price book)	Allowed with restrictions. Open-Market items not available from John Deere but offered by the delivering Dealer to complete the purchase of John Deere equipment awarded on contract. State and local agencies may purchase incidental miscellaneous parts, accessories and labor that are directly related to a specific item included on the contract. These types of items may not exceed \$5,000 for an individual purchase order. Total incidentals allowed on a single purchase order (Open Market by John Deere plus Open Market by Dealer) is \$5,000. Items must be clearly labeled on the purchase order or quote as Open Market.
