Non-contract equipment/items cannot total more than \$5000 nor be more than 50% of the purchase order total. Items must be clearly labeled on the purchase order as "open market (OM)/best value".</p> <p>Non-contract items are John Deere manufactured Order Zone products, implements, attachments, accessories, parts or bundles that are not currently on contract but are requested by the customer to complete the purchase of John Deere equipment awarded on contract.</p>
Rental	Not allowed on this contract.
