Quotes	Quotes are valid for 30 days from the creation date of the quote OR until the contract expires, <u>whichever</u> <u>occurs first</u> . All quotes created in JDQ2 have creation and expiration dates on the upper right hand corner of the first quote page for your convenience.
Allied – Non- John Deere Equipment	Allowed as long as the Allied equipment is compatible with the contract equipment being purchased. <u>Items must be clearly labeled on the purchase order or quote as Allied</u> . Allied equipment includes implements, attachments, accessories, bundles or parts requested by the customer to complete the equipment purchase.
	The total cost of the allied equipment must be less than 25% of the total cost of the contract item (including options and attachments).



	Example – If an item on contract has a total cost of \$100,000 (which includes all options and accessories which are also on contract), then the allied equipment (and its allied accessories) must be less than \$25,000.
