The John Deere PowerGard™ Protection Plan

Purchase a new or preowned John Deere combine with utmost confidence. The **PowerGard Protection Plan** delivers the protection you need. When a combine's engine or powertrain breaks down, it can be inconvenient and costly. The best way to assure that you have the proper protection against unforeseen, future repair bills is through the purchase of John Deere's **PowerGard Protection Plan**.

What does PowerGard cover?

All main components of the engine and powertrain, and select miscellaneous components are covered for mechanical breakdown caused by a defective component, due to faulty materials or original workmanship. The covered components include the following:

ENGINE – cylinder block, head, rocker arm cover, oil pan, timing gear covers and all parts contained inside these components, fuel injection pump and injectors, electronic fuel injection controller, turbocharger, flywheel, water pump, crankshaft seals, and oil seal housings, intake and exhaust manifolds attached to the cylinder head, oil coolers mounted directly to the engine, crankshaft torsional damper, and starter.

POWERTRAIN – engine gearcase, gearcase input shaft, hydrostatic drive pump and motor, propulsion transmission, final drives, and all parts and components contained inside any of these components.

MISCELLANEOUS – cylinder drive gearcase, the reverser gearcase, and all parts and components contained inside any of these components.

Which combines qualify for PowerGard Protection?

Both new and preowned John Deere combines may be eligible for **PowerGard Protection Plan**. Listed below are the specifics on equipment eligibility and requirements:

NEW JOHN DEERE COMBINES – all new John Deere combines can be purchased with the **PowerGard Protection Plan** during the “grace period” either at the time of initial sale, or within the first 95 days or 100 hours, for no additional surcharge.

Protection under **PowerGard** can also be added in the “delayed purchase period” up to 1 year or 350 hours of

operation after the start of the John Deere Basic Warranty. A surcharge is applied during this period.

PREOWNED JOHN DEERE COMBINES – select preowned John Deere combines held for sale at your local dealership may also be eligible for **PowerGard**. The equipment must have been manufactured in the past 6 years, have under 1,500 engine hours, and must pass a special “certification” process by a John Deere service technician.

How are preowned combines PowerGard “Certified”?

For a preowned John Deere combine to be eligible for **PowerGard**, it must pass a multiple point inspection and several tests, including oil scan, coolant scan, and transmission/hydraulic oil scan tests. Your local John Deere dealership service technician performs these inspections, checks, and tests on all **PowerGard**-ready units. John Deere combines are thoroughly inspected, checked, and approved, so you can be sure you are purchasing a used combine in good working condition that is eligible for **PowerGard**.

Look for this logo on every John Deere **PowerGard** Certified pre-owned cotton harvester.



Is the Protection Plan transferable?

Yes. Any remaining coverage is fully transferable to the new owner, should you sell or trade your John Deere equipment that is protected under **PowerGard**. This helps increase the value at trade-in time. Coverage is transferred when any machine with remaining coverage is sold. You incur no additional transfer fees or costs associated with this.

Your local John Deere dealership can repair or replace all covered components under the **PowerGard Protection Plan**.

PowerGard only uses Genuine John Deere Parts, which will guarantee that it is fixed right the first time, with the right parts that fit.
