Purchase a new John Deere self-propelled forage harvester or windrower with utmost confidence. The **PowerGard Protection Plan** delivers the protection you need. Powertrain break downs can be inconvenient and costly. The best way to assure that you have the proper protection against unforeseen, future engine or powertrain repair bills is through the purchase of John Deere's **PowerGard Protection Plan**.

What does PowerGard cover?

All **main components of the engine and powertrain** and select miscellaneous components, are covered for mechanical breakdown caused by a defective component, due to faulty materials, or original workmanship. The covered components include the following:

NEW SELF-PROPELLED FORAGE HARVESTERS ENGINE – cylinder block, head, rocker arm cover, oil pan, timing gear covers and all parts contained inside these components, fuel injection pump, injectors, electronic fuel injection controller, electronic unit injectors, turbocharger, flywheel, water pump, crankshaft seals, oil seal housings, intake and exhaust manifolds attached to the cylinder head, oil coolers mounted to the engine, crankshaft torsional damper, and starter. Non-John Deere engines are not covered by **PowerGard**.

POWERTRAIN – hydrostatic drive input shaft and input shaft housing, hydrostatic drive pump, charge pump, hydrostatic drive motor, transmission, final drives, and all parts and components contained inside any one of these components.

MISCELLANEOUS – bevel gearbox drive, the length of cut transmission, hydraulic pumps and motors, reverser motor, roll spacing adjusting motors, shearbar adjustment motors, horizontal and vertical sharpening stone adjustment motors, spout flap adjusting motor, power distribution circuit board, relay-diode circuit board, and all parts and components contained inside any of these components.

NEW WINDROWERS ENGINE – cylinder block, head, rocker arm cover, oil pan, timing gear covers and all parts contained inside these components, fuel injection pump and injectors,

electronic fuel injection controller, turbocharger, flywheel, water pump, crankshaft seals, oil seal housings, intake and exhaust manifolds attached to the cylinder head, oil coolers mounted to the engine, crankshaft torsional damper, and starter.

POWERTRAIN – tandem and charge pumps, ground drive motors, final drives, and all parts and components inside of any one of these components.

MISCELLANEOUS – platform drive pump, platform drive pump gearcase, platform drive motor, and all parts and components contained inside any one of these components.

Which hay equipment qualifies for PowerGard Protection?

All new John Deere self-propelled forage harvesters and windrowers may qualify for **PowerGard**, as long as the coverage is purchased within the first year or 350 hours after the start of the John Deere basic warranty.

Is the Protection Plan transferable?

Yes. Any remaining coverage is fully transferable to the new owner, should you sell or trade your John Deere equipment that is protected under **PowerGard**. This helps increase the value at trade-in time. Coverage is transferred when any machine with remaining coverage is sold. You incur no additional transfer fees or costs associated with this.

Your local John Deere dealership can repair or replace all covered components under the **PowerGard Protection Plan**.
