2007 TRACTOR RIDE -TRACTOR AND IMPLEMENT SHOW
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. All Participant Contracts must be signed by the Participant if the Participant is an individual or by an authorized representative of the Participant if the Participant is a business, firm, or other organization, and returned to Deere & Company (John Deere) along with the deposit by date indicated on the enclosed invoice.
2. Payment in full is required no later than one (1) day prior to the event.
3. If the Participant must cancel its participation in an event, the deposit will be refunded in full if John Deere receives notification of cancellation at least 30 days prior to the event.
4. The Participant shall not bring or permit any vendor of goods or services on John Deere property without the advance written consent of John Deere. The Participant is fully responsible for all arrangements and any contract entered into with such vendor allowed by John Deere.
5. The Participant, its employees, agents, guests, invitees and participants are expected to depart from John Deere property at the conclusion of the event. The Participant shall be responsible for the appropriate conduct of itself, its employees, agents, guests and invitees at all times while on John Deere property. John Deere reserves the right to remove any person from its property who is not conducting himself or herself in an appropriate manner, as determined by John Deere. John Deere also reserves the right to remove, safeguard or take other appropriate action with respect to any property that might create a threat of danger or security risk to people or property.
6. The Participant agrees that John Deere is NOT responsible in any manner for damage, destruction, or loss of any property, equipment, goods, merchandise or other items occurring prior to, during, or following any event. John Deere makes no warranties or representations whatsoever to Participant, its employees, agents, guests, invitees or to any other participant or attendee at an event.
7. The Participant is at all times responsible and shall reimburse John Deere, the City Moline for any and all damage, loss, injury, death or other liability of any nature whatsoever to people or property, equipment, goods, merchandise or other items incurred by John Deere or by the Participant or any of the Participant's employees, guests, agents, invitees or any other participants, including persons or organizations contracted by the Participant to provide any service, food, entertainment, or goods before, during, or following the event, even with the advance permission of John Deere. The Participant agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless John Deere, its officers, directors, employees, agents, and contractors from and against any such claims, demands, suits, damages, liability, costs, and expenses (including reasonable attorney fees) incurred in connection with any such damage, loss, injury, death or other liability, or by reason of the breach of this Participant Contract, or by reason of any breach by Participant of any contract it has with any other person, firm or organization.
8. No item of any kind can be affixed or placed on any facility (public or private) walls, floors, ceilings or equipment. The Participant shall not permit any employee, agent, guest, invitee, event participant or contracted party to deface, damage, or otherwise injure any John Deere property or facility in any manner whatsoever.
9. Transportation, delivery and pick up of all equipment, property, goods, merchandise, items and personnel brought for the event are and shall remain the sole responsibility of the Participant. Set up of equipment may take place on the day before the event ONLY, and tear down shall be completed promptly at the end of the event.
10. Insurance Requirements:
 - a. The Participant must at all times have and maintain a reasonable and adequate amount of property damage insurance to protect against loss, damage or destruction for the full insurable value of any property, equipment, goods, merchandise or other items owned by, or in the care, custody, or control of Participant, for the entire period of time while on John Deere property. Participant must also carry reasonably adequate liability insurance protection for bodily injury and property damage claims, including contractual and personal injury liability coverage, for any death, injury, damage or destruction done to any person or property, including those of John Deere.
 - b. Umbrella or excess liability insurance may be used to meet Participant's requirements.
 - c. Each policy required under this Participant Contract shall contain a severability of interests clause and will provide that the Participant's coverage shall be primary to any other insurance available to or maintained by John Deere, its parent, subsidiary and affiliated companies. Upon request by John Deere, the Participant will provide written proof of insurance as required above.
11. John Deere at all times reserves the right to inspect, monitor, and secure all public and private events.
12. The Participant is responsible for all permits, licenses, taxes and other legal requirements imposed on or associated with the Participant's event or activities on John Deere property, including compliance with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations. The Participant further agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless John Deere, the City of Moline, their employees, agents, and contractors with respect to all such obligations.
15. John Deere's obligation under this Agreement to make the rented space available will be relieved if anything outside of its control prevents the Participant space or John Deere facility from being available at the date and time scheduled for the event. This includes such occurrences as natural disasters, fires, destruction, war, governmental orders, quarantines, or any other forces or events outside of John Deere's control. If such occurs, John Deere will refund the Participant's deposit and fee already paid in full, or prorated based on the available space and time actually used by the Participant, but will have no other liability on account of such cancellation or unavailability of the use of the rented space or facility.
14. All John Deere facilities have a non-smoking policy, and the Participant is responsible to ensure that its employees, agents, guests, invitees and other participants all abide by such policy.
15. This Participant Contract constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and may not be modified or amended without the express written agreement of the parties. The Participant shall not assign or transfer this Participant Contract, or attempt to do so, without the advance written consent of John Deere. Any assignment, transfer or attempt in violation of this provision shall be null and void.
16. This Participant Contract is governed by the law of Illinois, without regard to conflict of laws. The Participant agrees that any enforcement or suit on this Participant Contract shall be instituted in the courts of Illinois.
17. By entering into this Participant Contract, the Participant agrees that the Participant has full power, authority and legal capacity to do so. This Participant Contract does not constitute a lease of any John Deere property, but merely a temporary, revocable license to use and be upon John Deere property for the specific event associated with this Participant Contract.
