

*For the installation of software on the Starfire™ 6000, there are two options to initiate programming of the receiver.*

### **Option I – Starfire™ 6000 Receiver USB Direct**

#### **At Computer**

1. Download the new software and save the .zip file to your computer (desktop).
2. Select the file that is now on your desktop and **extract** the data (this is the same as unzip) to your desktop.
3. Using a USB storage device a specific file structure will need to be created. (**Note - the folder names will need to be in the English Language**)
  - a. First create a folder and title it “**Programs**”
  - b. Create a secondary folder within the “Programs” folder titled “**Receiver**”
4. Copy the extracted file to the USB storage device file structure - **Programs > Receiver**
  - a. Verify that you have a **.gst** file on our USB storage device within the receiver folder.

If you have a **.gst** file in the receiver folder the software is now ready to be installed.

#### **At Machine**

1. Identify the StarFire 6000 USB port on the bottom of the receiver
  2. Insert your USB with the correct **.gst** file embedded and proceed to the display within the cab to initiate download.
  3. At the display, follow the steps below to initiate the programming of the StarFire 6000
    - a. Select “Main Menu”
    - b. Select “StarFire 6000” icon
    - c. Select “USB Drive” (softkey “A”)
    - d. Select “Update Receiver”
    - e. Select correct file for programming
- Note – the process typically takes 3 minutes to process completely***
- f. When prompted, select “continue” button to proceed to normal working functionality

## **Option II- Starfire™ 6000 Receiver with GreenStar™ Display**

### **At Computer**

**Necessary tools: USB or Datacard for specific display**

1. Verify your storage device has ‘Live Update’
  - a. ‘Live Update’ is available for download via Stellar Downloads & Updates
  - b. Save the ‘Live Update’ for the correct display to the corresponding storage device
2. Download the new software for the Starfire™ 6000 and save the .zip file to your computer (desktop)
3. Select the file that is now on your desktop and **extract** the data (this is the same as unzip).
  - a. Copy the extracted .gst file to the **Receiver** folder located inside the **Programs** folder.
4. Verify that you have a .gst file on our storage device within the receiver folder.

### **At Machine**

1. Insert the storage device into the display.
2. Using the menu, select **Message Center**.
3. Select softkey “A” (Reprogram Device).
4. Highlight **GPS Receiver** and select **Reprogram Device**.
5. In the drop-down box beside **Change to Version**, select your desired software version.
6. Select the Accept button.  
*Note - process typically takes 40-60 minutes to complete*
7. When prompted, select “continue” button to proceed to normal working functionality
