New Features:

- **Machine Profiles** – This release includes the addition of profiles to the AutoTrac™ Universal to enhance operator experience when transferring the AutoTrac™ Universal to varying machines. This includes the ability to create and store up to five (5) unique profiles, storing the associated settings and calibration with each.
- **Serial Number Identification Change** – This release includes a change to the ‘Motor Information’ tab, where the last six digits of the controller serial number are now visible. This is used to account for hardware serial number breaks, as well as reduce confusion.
- **Seat Switch Check During Calibration** – This release includes the addition of seat switch step to the ‘Steering Ratio Calibration’, when Operator Presence is set to seat switch. This allows the controller to recognize various seat switch voltage changes across varying makes and models to improve operator experience.

Resolved Items:

- **Added DTC USC 517801.12** – This release includes the addition of a new DTC to identify when the controller is in AutoTrac™ Universal mode but recognizes when a flow switch is connected.
 - **Virtual Terminal (VT) Available in Dual Display** – This release fixes the issue of the AutoTrac™ Universal 300 VT being unavailable when the implement viewer was turned ‘Off’ on the CommandCenter™ due to duplicate address claiming.
