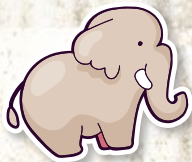
### Tractor of the month

# Cardboard: Your little Easter lamb

How to make cute little lambs from paper plates.

## What you'll need:

-  White paper plates
-  White cotton balls
-  Coloured craft paper for ears, nose and legs
-  Felt-tip pens or stickers for decoration
-  Scissors and glue
-  Optional: white paint, googly eyes

Ask your parents for help if necessary.



**1.** Take a paper plate and make it as fluffy as a lamb's fleece by sticking cotton balls on it. If your plate isn't white, no problem! Just paint it with white paint and leave to dry.

**2.** Stick a piece of pink craft paper in the middle of the paper plate as a nose.

**3.** Add the eyes by cutting out small circles from paper or using googly eyes.

**4.** Cut the ears out of black craft paper and glue them to the top. The legs should be glued to the back of the paper plate.

**5.** Use felt-tip pens or stickers to decorate the Easter lamb. For example, draw a small mouth, eyelashes, heart-shaped cheeks ...

Once the glue has dried, everyone can admire the cute little Easter lamb.

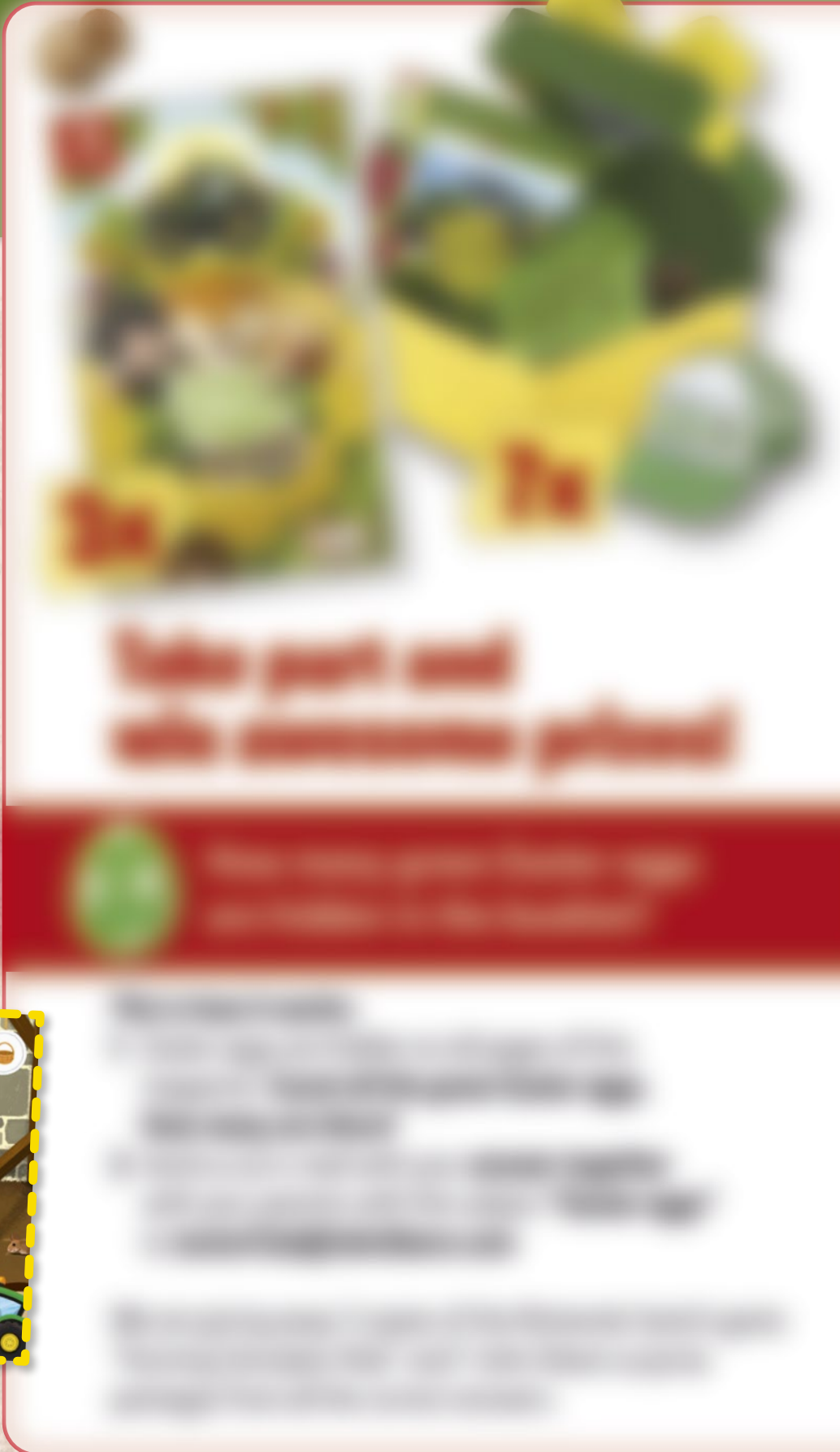

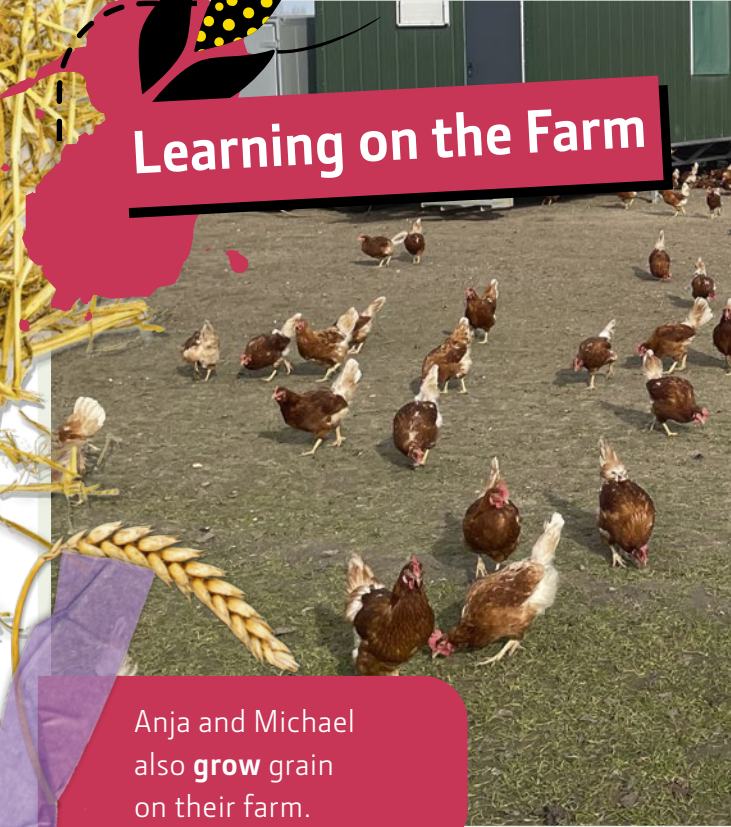

## Experience fun on the farm: **Agriculture, alpacas and adventure**

Anja and Michael also **grow** grain on their farm.

As part of the “Learning on the Farm” initiative in Baden-Württemberg, children can discover where our food comes from. More than 450 farms are taking part. You can get to know the animals and plants better during a visit. And learn how important farming is. We had a look around Anja and Michael’s farm.

### Hi kids,

My name is Noah and I am an alpaca. Together with my friend Lucius, I live on Anja Rose and Michael Brand’s farm in Altlußheim near Hockenheim. Alpacas are not typical farm animals. We are a real help here on the farm. What we are really good at is herd protection. We watch over Anja and Michael’s chickens. The chickens sleep here at night in the mobile barn on the pasture. During the day, however, the chickens run around in the meadow. Lucius and I make sure that they are safe from birds of prey.





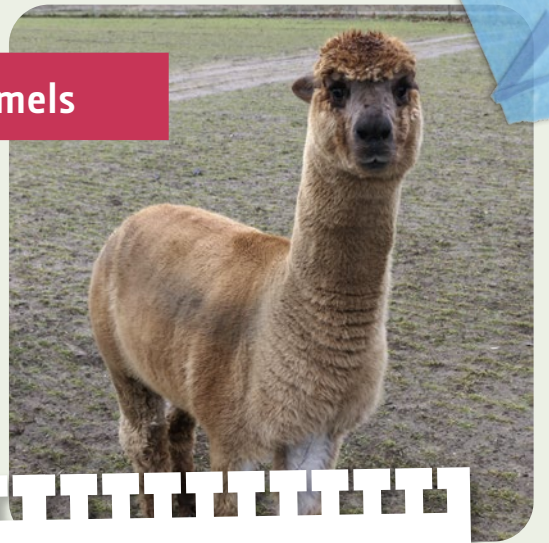
## Fluffy friends

**Alpacas are particularly** popular with children because of their soft fur and cute curly hairstyles. The animals' ancestors come from South America. Alpacas are now also bred in Germany. Lucius and Noah are curious, but also vigilant. This is a good quality for protectors.

## Spitting camels

### Alpacas are often confused with llamas.

Alpacas are significantly smaller and lighter than llamas. Although they have no humps, both species belong to the camel family. But they can all spit! That's what they do under stress. But Lucius and Noah only spit at each other.
