All purchase orders must show Deere & Company as the vendor and reference the contract number.

Contract Details

Delivery Obligations	None.
Fees	<p>A \$4 per loaded mile delivery charge is allowed and is optional. The charge should be clearly indicated on the agency's purchase order.</p> <p>Mileage distance will be the distance from the delivery starting point to the customer's delivery point ONLY. Mileages should be calculated using Google Maps. The ordering agency may use the dealer for delivery, may pick-up the equipment or may contract for delivery with anyone it chooses.</p>

Financing	Not Allowed. No financing or leasing allowed.
Machine Hours	Allowed: Due to factory delivery, pre-delivery inspection, machine setup and installation of attachments, machines may have hours but should not exceed hour usage guidelines in the warranty administration manual.
Manuals	An operator's manual is included with the delivery of the equipment at no charge.
Miscellaneous	None.
Multiple Unit Discount	No Multiple Unit Discount offered.
Open Market by John Deere (listed in the price book)	<p>Allowed with restrictions. Open-Market items are implements, attachments, accessories, parts and bundles that are not currently on contract, but are requested by the customer to complete the purchase of John Deere equipment awarded on contract.</p> <p>State and local agencies may purchase incidental miscellaneous parts, accessories and labor that are directly related to a specific item included on the contract. <u>These types of items may not exceed \$5,000 for an individual purchase order.</u> Total incidentals allowed on a single purchase order (non-contract Deere equipment plus allied equipment) is \$5,000. <u>Items must be clearly labeled on the purchase order or quote as Open Market.</u></p>
Open Market by Dealer (not listed in the price book)	<p>Allowed with restrictions. Open-Market items not available from John Deere but offered by the delivering Dealer to complete the purchase of John Deere equipment awarded on contract. State and local agencies may purchase incidental miscellaneous parts, accessories and labor that are directly related to a specific item included on the contract. <u>These types of items may not exceed \$5,000 for an individual purchase order.</u> Total incidentals allowed on a single purchase order (allied equipment plus non-contract Deere equipment) is \$5,000. <u>Items must be clearly labeled on the purchase order or quote as Open Market.</u></p>

Substitutions	Not Allowed: Contract prohibits substitutions.

Trade-ins

Allowed: Items must be clearly labeled on the purchase order or quote as Trade-In. The agency and the dealer will determine the trade-in value.

State agencies must obtain approval from the Department of Administration and must follow the requirements for liquidation of surplus goods. CPV Members are solely responsible for compliance with their local government's requirements for liquidation of surplus goods.
