

**SOUTH CAROLINA-Grounds Maintenance Equipment-Phase II**

<b>Contract Number:</b>	4400031314
<b>Contract Period:</b>	June 1, 2023 – May 31, 2026
<b>Eligibility:</b>	This is a statewide term contract for the purchase of commercial grounds maintenance equipment, accessories, and attachments to be used by state agencies, political subdivisions, local governments, cities, counties, schools, colleges, and universities.

**Quotes and Purchase Orders:**

Quotes are valid for 30 days from the creation date of the quote **OR** until the contract expires, whichever occurs first.

To obtain a quote, contact your local [John Deere Dealer](#). Submit your purchase order to the dealer. The John Deere Dealer will submit the purchase order to John Deere's Government Sales office.

**All purchase orders must show Deere & Company as the vendor and reference the contract number.**

**Contract Details**

Fees	<b>Delivery Charge</b> An optional delivery charge of \$6.00 per loaded mile is allowed for the delivering dealer. This fee is <u>not</u> per machine; it's per load. The agency must agree to the fee. If charged, the fee must appear as a separate line item on the quote or purchase order. Use <a href="#">Google Maps</a> to calculate the mileage.
Financing	<b>Not Allowed:</b> Contract prohibits financing.
Machine Hours	<b>Not Allowed:</b> Due to factory delivery, pre-delivery inspection, machine setup and installation of attachments, machines may have minimal hours. Machines designated as demos are not allowed.
Manuals	An operator's manual is included with the delivery of the equipment at no charge. Electronic versions are acceptable.  Dealer will be reimbursed for manuals listed on the quote.
Miscellaneous	<b>Training:</b> Upon request, dealer shall demonstrate equipment within 30 days after delivery.  <b>Warranty:</b> Must provide manufacturer's standard written warranty upon delivery.

Multiple Unit Discount	<p>Sales of 3 or more like self-propelled products sold on the same purchase order are eligible for the multi-unit discount. The 3 or more self-propelled products must be in the same equipment categories as shown below and included on the same purchase order. Substitutions	Not applicable. This is a current price contract.										
Trade-ins	<p><b>Allowed:</b> Subject to the following terms and conditions:</p> <p><b>State Agencies:</b> At the sole discretion of the agency, agency may request to trade in obsolete equipment. Dealer shall offer fair and reasonable trade amount with an itemized detailed list of credits. Trade-in process will be as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Agency will provide information regarding items to be traded.</li> <li>• Dealer will place value on items.</li> </ul>										

- Agency will forward a turn-in document to the Surplus Property Management Officer (SPMO) showing proposed value along with a statement that price is fair and reasonable.
- SPMO will approve or disapprove the trade-in.
- If approved, credit applied to purchase.

**All Other Agencies:** Trade-ins are governed by the agency's local rules, regulations, and procedures.

Items must be clearly labeled on the purchase order or quote as Trade-In. The agency and the dealer determine the trade-in value.
